★ — IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR PARENTS — ★



1) MEDICATION

The Department of Health stipulates that children who are ill are not permitted to attend school. We have a responsibility towards other children and parents to ensure that all children stay at home and do not affect the health of others, especially in the case of contagious illnesses.

Please complete the medication form in detail if your child requires medication during school hours, e.g. antibiotics. You will be notified immediately if your child becomes ill at school.

He/she will be removed from class and taken to the sickbay. If your child has a fever, we will contact the parent for permission to administer Panado® syrup according to the child's age. If you prefer us to administer a different pain reliever, make sure it is in the child's bag every day. It is the parent's responsibility to ensure that all medication is clearly labelled and not expired.



2) PERSONAL BELONGINGS

Please mark your child's clothing, bottles, blankets, etc. The school will not be held responsible for the loss of any items.

Children are not permitted to bring toys to school as this causes many tears with classmates. The item will be taken away and only sent back on a Friday.

Children should not wear new clothes to school as their activities like painting and playing in the sandpit will make them dirty.



3) LATE ARRIVAL & PICKUP POLICY

If you are not able to pick up your child by 18h00, alternate arrangements must be made.

Please notify the principal if any unauthorised person will be picking up your child.

A late fee will be charged if the child remains in the care after 18h00.



4) POTTY TRAINING

We will work in conjunction with parents during potty training. If you have a method that has been working for you, please let us know and we will adopt it for your child.



5) BIRTHDAYS

- A birthday is a great event in a child's life. Parents are welcome to make arrangements with the Principal before hand to bring refreshments on this day to celebrate your child's birthday.
- Parents are welcome to send a cake or cupcakes, drinks, party packs and decorations to school.
- Parties are celebrated during the 1st snack at 10:00am.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR PARENTS



1) TUCK SHOP

We have a tuck shop every Friday. We allow kids to bring spending according to age, this is just to teach children independence with money and shopping.



Important: Always fill the amount you sending in the money form in the message book, as children do tend to play with the money and it gets missed placed.

2) CLASSES IN DISNEY ACADEMY

The school has six classes:

- **Bambis**
3 months to walking stage
- **Nemos**
18 months to 2 years
- **Dalmatians**
2 to 3 years
- **Mickey Mouse**
Grade RRR - 3 to 4 years
- **Monsters**
Grade RR - 4 to 5 years
- **Toy Story**
Grade R - 5 to 6 years

3) STATIONERY

- Specific items are required for each child (please mark all items with your child's name).
- Stationery can be purchased from the office at request.
- Note: The stationery you buy from the school will be used for the entire year. If you are purchasing stationery on your own, make sure you buy the requested quantity. If not, you will be sent with a stationery list during the course of the year.



All blankets should be clearly marked with your child's name. Blankets will be sent every Friday for washing and should be returned on the Monday morning. If you forget to send the blanket, we do keep blankets at the school we will assist for the day.

4) BAMBIS (3 MONTHS TO WALKING STAGE)

- Marked bag with 3 sets of extra clothes
- Provide food or purity until your child can eat solids
- Enough pampers: minimum 4 for half day and 6 for full day
- Bottom cream and wet-wipes
- Bottles with the correct amount water, pre-measured milk powder in a dispenser
- A4 hardcover book (communication book)
- Please note: If your child does not come with pampers or wet-wipes the school will provide at a cost
- A thin receiving blanket for summer and a warm thick blanket for winter. (Write your child's name on the blanket)

5) NEMOS (18 MONTHS TO 2 YEARS)

- A marked bag with 2 sets of extra clothes
- A blanket (thin for summer and thick for winter) write your child's name on the blanket
- Sun hat for the hot summer days
- Sunscreen for the hot summer days
- A mosquito repellent during summer
- Potty training children bring pull-ups cimbies
- Bottom cream and wet-wipes

6) DALMATIANS (2 TO 3 YEARS)

- A marked bag with 2 sets of extra clothes
- A blanket (thin for summer and thick for winter) write your child's name on the blanket
- Potty training children should bring pull-ups
- Wet-wipes and if you would still require to use bottom cream
- Sun screen for the hot summer days
- Sun hat for the hot summer days
- A mosquito repellent for summer

7) MICKEY MOUSE GRADE RRR (3 TO 4 YEARS)

- A marked bag with 1 set of extra clothes
- A blanket (thin for summer and a thick blanket for winter) write your child's name on the blanket
- Sun hat for the hot summer days
- Sun screen for the hot summer days
- A mosquito repellent
- At this age most kids are potty trained however if your little one is still in the process, send pull-up cimbies

8) MONSTERS GRADE RR (4 TO 5 YEARS)

- A marked bag with 1 set of extra clothes
- A blanket (thin blanket for summer and thick blanket for winter) write your child's name on the blanket
- Sun hat for the hot summer days
- Sun screen for the hot summer days
- A mosquito repellent

9) TOY STORY GRADE R (5 TO 6 YEARS)

- A thin blanket for summer a thick blanket for winter
- Sun hat for the hot summer days
- Sun screen for the hot summer days
- A mosquito repellent



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
